Read and follow the directions to make a Thanksgiving placemat. You will need the following supplies:

- 1 large piece of construction paper
- 6 strips of construction paper
- 1 stick of glue
 - 1 brown turkey
 - 1 marker (your choice of color)
- 1. Fold the long piece of construction paper in half long ways.
- 2. Turn the paper so the folded side is at the bottom.
- 3. Cut along the black lines and stop at the black triangle. Be careful to not cut completely through the paper.
- 4. Take one strip of construction paper and pull it up through the first slit in the large piece of construction paper.
- 5. Push the strip of construction paper down into the next slit.
- 6. Continue the up and down pattern across the large piece of construction paper until the strip of paper is completely weaved.
- 7. Carefully slide the strip down until it is against the edge.
- 8. Repeat steps **4-7**, remember to alternate starting the strip of paper up and down. This should make a weaving pattern.
- 9. Glue all edges of the strips to your placemat.
- 10. Use the marker, in the first row, write "Happy"
- 11. In the third row, write Thanksgiving.
- 12. Glue a brown turkey in one of the lower corners.
- 13. Glue the acorn under the word Thanksgiving.
- 14. Write your name and the date in the opposite corner of the turkey.
- 15. Turn in on the brown chair on the stage.
